PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATION:

Proposal to legalize and maintain a rear one-storey addition of a two-storey semi-detached dwelling.

REQUESTED VARIANCE(S) TO THE ZONING BY-LAW:

1. **Chapter 10.40.30.40.(1)(A), By-law 569-2013**
The maximum permitted lot coverage is 35% of the lot area (53.03 m²).
The lot coverage will be 50.66% of the lot area (76.76 m²).

2. **Chapter 10.40.40.40.(1)(A), By-law 569-2013**
The maximum permitted floor space index is 0.75 times the area of the lot (113.63 m²).
The floor space index will be 0.79 times the area of the lot (119.69 m²).

3. Chapter 10.40.40.70.(2)(A), By-law 569-2013

The minimum required rear yard setback is 7.5 m.
The rear yard setback will be 6.35 m.

1. Section 7.2.3, By-law 6752

The maximum permitted lot coverage is 35% of the lot area (53.03 m²)
The lot coverage will be 50.66% of the lot area (76.76 m²)

2. Section 7.2.3, By-law 6752

The maximum permitted floor space index is 0.75 times the lot area (113.63 m²).
The floor space index will be 0.79 times the lot area (119.69 m²).

3. Section 7.2.3, By-law 6752

The minimum required rear yard setback is 9.0 m.
The rear yard setback will be 6.35 m.

THE COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT & MINOR VARIANCES

The role of the Committee of Adjustment is to provide flexibility in dealing with minor adjustments to zoning by-law requirements. To approve such variances, the Committee must be satisfied that:

- the variance requested is minor;
- the proposal is desirable for the appropriate development or use of the land and/or building;
- the general intent and purpose of the City's Zoning Code and/or By-law are maintained; and
- the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan are maintained.

The Committee of Adjustment forms its opinion through its detailed review of all material filed with an application, letters received, deputations made at the public hearing and results of site inspections.

MAKING YOUR VIEWS KNOWN

The notice has been mailed to you, as required by the *Planning Act*, to ensure that, as an interested person, you may make your views known by:

- **Attending the Public Hearing.** Attendant Care Services can be made available with some advance notice.
- **Sending a letter by Mail, E-mail, or Fax.** Information you choose to disclose in your correspondence will be used to receive your views on the relevant issue(s) to enable the Committee to make its decision on this matter. This information will become part of the public record.

If you do not attend the public hearing, or express your views in writing, the Committee may make a decision in your absence, and may recommend changes to the proposal

- The Committee will announce its decision on the application at the Public Hearing.
- To receive a copy of the Decision, fill out the Decision Request Form at our office or at the Public Hearing or write a letter requesting a copy of the Decision and send it to our office.
- If you wish to appeal a Decision of the Committee, you must file your written request for a decision with the Deputy Secretary-Treasurer.
- Be advised that the appeal body may dismiss an appeal of the consent Decision if the person or public body that filed the appeal did not make a submission to the Committee of Adjustment prior to the Decision having been made.
