**PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATION:**

To alter the existing one-storey detached dwelling by constructing a rear ground floor addition, a complete second storey addition, a rear basement walkout, a new front porch, a new rear ground floor deck, and front and rear second storey balconies.

**REQUESTED VARIANCE(S) TO THE ZONING BY-LAW:**

- 1. Chapter 10.40.30.40.(1)(A), By-law 569-2013**  
The maximum permitted lot coverage is 35% of the lot area (100.63 m<sup>2</sup>).  
The lot coverage will be equal to 41.8% of the lot area (120.23 m<sup>2</sup>).
- 2. Chapter 10.40.40.10.(2)(B)(ii), By-law 569-2013**  
The maximum permitted height of all side exterior main walls facing a side lot line is 7 m.  
The height of the side exterior main walls facing a side lot line will be 8.48 m.
- 1. Section 7.5.3, By-law 6752**  
The maximum permitted lot coverage is 35% of the lot area (100.63 m<sup>2</sup>).  
The lot coverage will be equal to 44.8% of the lot area (129.02 m<sup>2</sup>).
- 2. Section 7.5.3, By-law 6752**  
The minimum required north side yard setback is 0.6 m.  
The altered detached house will be located 0.4 m from the north side lot line.

## **THE COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT & MINOR VARIANCES**

The role of the Committee of Adjustment is to provide flexibility in dealing with minor adjustments to zoning by-law requirements. To approve such variances, the Committee must be satisfied that:

- the variance requested is minor;
- the proposal is desirable for the appropriate development or use of the land and/or building;
- the general intent and purpose of the City's Zoning Code and/or By-law are maintained; and
- the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan are maintained.

The Committee of Adjustment forms its opinion through its detailed review of all material filed with an application, letters received, deputations made at the public hearing and results of site inspections.

The notice has been mailed to you, as required by the *Planning Act*, to ensure that, as an interested person, you may make your views known by:

- **Attending the Public Hearing.** Attendant Care Services can be made available with some advance notice.
- **Sending a letter by Mail, E-mail, or Fax.** Information you choose to disclose in your correspondence will be used to receive your views on the relevant issue(s) to enable the Committee to make its decision on this matter. This information will become part of the public record.

If you do not attend the public hearing, or express your views in writing, the Committee may make a decision in your absence, and may recommend changes to the proposal
