

Line 2 closed – Pape to St George stations

Parking restrictions to speed transit and traffic on Danforth and Bloor

Date: Sunday, June 12, 2016

Work description and purpose

Subway service will be suspended between Pape and St George stations on June 12 for TTC maintenance work on the Prince Edward Viaduct. This work is essential to provide long term subway reliability.

Shuttle buses will operate between Pape and St George station during the closure. Regular subway service resumes on Monday, June 13 at 6 a.m. The next subway closure between these two stations is scheduled for the weekend of August 13 and 14, 2016.

Pilot parking restrictions on Danforth and Bloor on Sunday, June 12

During the Sunday subway closure, TTC will be conducting a parking pilot on Danforth Avenue and Bloor Street to keep transit and vehicular traffic moving as fast as possible for TTC customers and all road users.

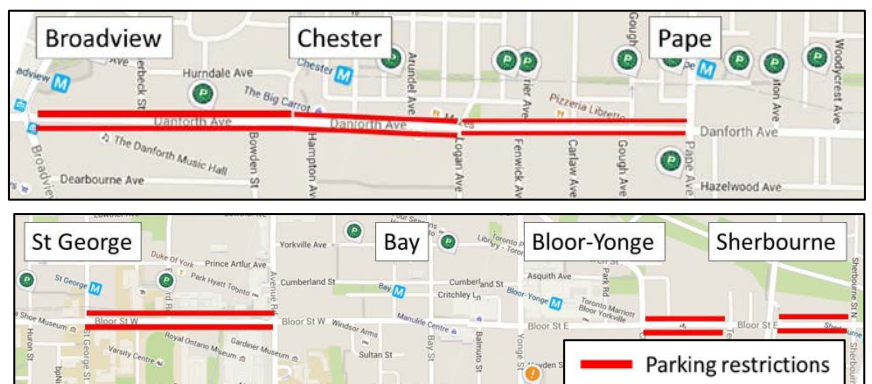
The following parking restrictions will be in effect between 3:30 a.m. Sunday to 12:01 a.m. Monday:

Both sides of Danforth Avenue between:

- Pape to Broadview avenues

Both sides of Bloor Street between:

- St George Street to Avenue Road
- Church Street to Ted Rogers Way
- Huntley to Sherbourne streets



TTC and the City implemented similar parking restrictions on April 9-10 and May 7-8 during subway closures between Bathurst and Jane stations. When parking was restricted on Bloor Street between Bathurst and Jane streets, travel times were improved by 30 to 40 percent.

Transit service – articulated shuttle buses

All subway trains will turn back eastbound at Pape Station and westbound at St George Station.

During this closure, approximately 35 to 40 articulated shuttle buses will run on Bloor Street and Danforth Avenue between the two stations, stopping at each major station intersection. Articulated buses will increase the overall carrying capacity of the service, and will move TTC customers more reliably.

PRESTO may not be available on all shuttle buses. PRESTO card users should carry tokens or exact cash in case the bus that arrives does not have PRESTO.

For customers requiring a station with an elevator, Wheel-Trans buses will operate between Pape and St George stations upon request. Customers can request the Wheel-Trans bus by speaking with a Supervisor at these stations.
